**IMPORANT**: Mosaic Christian College operates on an open enrollment model that allows students to begin courses at any point throughout the year. However, most students progress at a consistent pace of one course per month, which serves as the basis for our academic planning and scheduling expectations. Over the course of a 12-month academic year, students typically complete 12 courses, equating to 36 credit hours in an undergraduate program or equivalent pacing in graduate and doctoral programs.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The timeline provided reflects an average pace. Your actual completion time may vary slightly depending on your personal schedule and availability. The primary goal is to ensure that each student has sufficient time to fully engage with and retain the course material.
